Attendees

Do I need to print my ticket?

No, as long as you registered through Eventbrite. Be prepared to give the same name you registered under at check in or email address you registered with.

Is parking free?

There is no free parking on Temple's campus. Parking information can be found on the event website: www.kencrest.org/disability-summit/. If you require an ADA or handicap accessible space, please email kencrest.communications@kencrest.org no later than September 12th to secure an accessible space near the student center.

Where should I enter at the Student Center?

Use the 13th street entrance to the Student Center and take the elevator to the 2nd floor.

Will food be provided?

Yes, both a continental breakfast (bagels, fruit, danishes) and a boxed lunch will be provided.
